Taking full advantage of his tastes and experience, Mick has created lyrics and melodies that encompass a variety of emotions and blues stylings, and delivers vocal performances that complement every song. Together with the musicians who helped him put this together, Mick has once again delivered a real feast for his listeners. This album is a celebration of the blues in all its glory, with support by some of the genre's fastest rising stars.


